**PERSONAL PARISH**

*The responsibility of the care of that portion of Christ's flock which has been solemnly committed to the Archbishop of Seattle demands that the arrangement of parishes be so constituted or changed that it may more fully bring about an increase in Catholic life, and may provide for the good of souls and promote the glory of the Most High God.*

*Moved by this consideration and by the desire to provide for the convenience of the residents of a rapidly growing area, we now provide for the establishment of these new personal parishes within the Archdiocese.*

*Therefore, after having heard the Presbyteral Council and as far as it was possible and necessary, having consulted with others who have interest in the matter, we have arrived at a definite decision by carefully considering all the factors involved and hereby erect and establish the following personal parishes and grant to them and their duly commissioned pastors all the privileges, honors, and prerogatives which, by the Law of the Church, are enjoyed by other parishes and their pastors.*

*The faithful who register and/or regularly participate in the liturgical and sacramental life of these parishes are deemed to be their members.*
